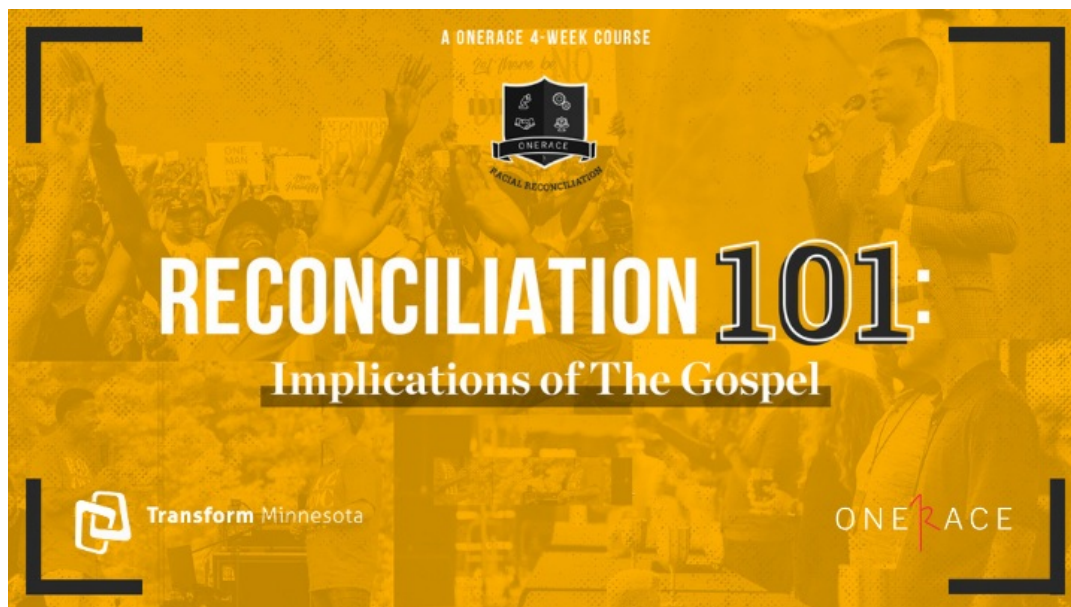

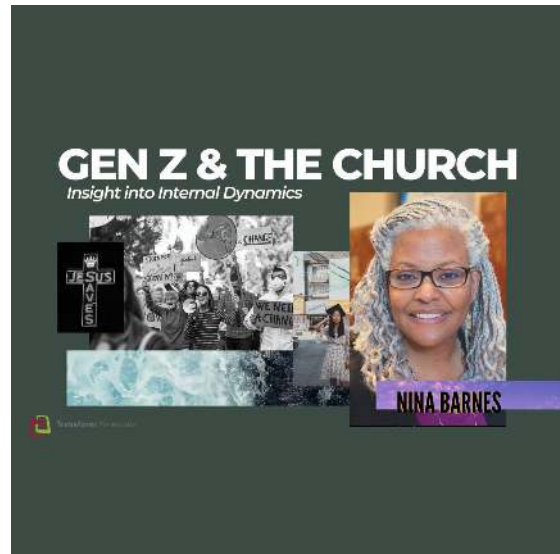
We are thrilled to offer Reconciliation 101 starting on April 29, 2021. This is a 4-week

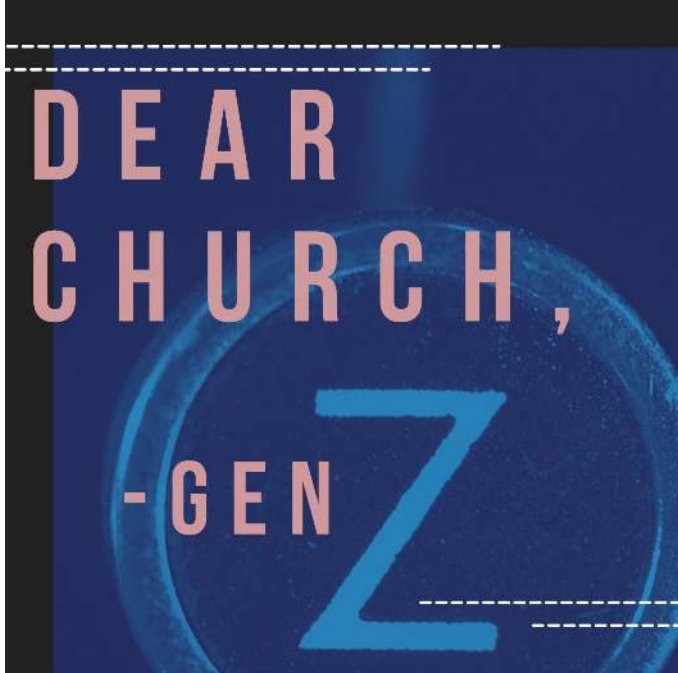

Letter to the Church, from a Gen Z Biblical Theology Student

Dear Church,

...Gen Z seems to hold a collective responsibility to fix all of the issues (historic and present) causing the world to be so broken. We are often told that 'the world was once a better place'. Since we feel this sense of responsibility, we don't process anything as truth until we have comprehended it for ourselves. We work hard to understand as much as we can, asking questions along the way, because we want to be a part of resolving the issues we see around us. Sometimes this approach is misunderstood as questioning authority, but we do this to help



strengthen and define our worldview and gain a better understanding of our surroundings. This is partly why Gen Z has a hard time with Church culture, because we don't have a safe space to ask questions...
