Multiple bills signed into law at the end of this legislative session are bringing **significant changes to Minnesota's employment law landscape** for all employers, including churches and ministries. **Churches and ministries must be prepared to comply with these changes**, including updating existing policies, employee handbooks, and workplace rules, as many new laws or modifications become **effective on July 1, 2023**.
